Wharf Rules & Guidelines - Effective from 1st April 2021

1. The Vessel described in the Contract Application must:-
 - 1.1. Display a valid Bridgewaer Canal Company licence.
 - 1.2. Have appropriate Vessel Insurance cover including Third Party Liability.
 - 1.3. Hold a current Boat Safety Certificate or other equivalent document.
2. Mooring fees are payable either monthly, quarterly or yearly in advance, depending on your contract with the Company.
3. In the event of any failed payment transaction by an Owner to the Company, a fee of £50 will be levied for each instance.
4. The LOA of the Vessel must not exceed the Allocated Length of a Mooring.
5. The Premises is also used for wharfage, i.e. the loading, unloading and transshipment of cargo, and the Company reserves the right to move vessels to facilitate wharfage.
6. Persons under the age of 16 years must be accompanied and supervised at all times by a responsible adult from the same Vessel.
7. Use of illegal substances will not be tolerated and will lead to immediate termination of contract without notice.
8. Water levels are not guaranteed and it is the Owners' responsibility to ensure the Vessel is secured in such a way as to cope with fluctuations in water level.
9. Fishing at the Wharf or Premises is not permitted.
10. Swimming at the Wharf or Premises is not permitted.
11. Owners shall refuel their Vessel only at the designated fuelling quay and are to vacate the quay when the fuelling operation is complete.
12. Animals other than domestic pets may only be accommodated at the Wharf or Premises with the Company's prior written consent.
13. Domestic pets including but not limited to cats and dogs are allowed at the Wharf or Premises at the discretion of the Company.
14. Owners must ensure that their pets:-
 - 14.1. Are kept on a secure leash no more 3 metres long under the supervision of a competent handler.
 - 14.2. Are not left unattended at any point
 - 14.3. Are not allowed to stray onto any areas defined by the Company.
 - 14.4. Fouling is cleaned up immediately.
15. Electrical and signal cables attached or otherwise shall be dressed as to not to cause nuisance or danger.
16. Whilst the Company will make every effort to maintain an electrical power, water, or other supply to the Mooring, the Company cannot be held responsible for any interruption to the supplies.
17. Open fires are not permitted within the vicinity of the Vessel, Mooring, or any part of the Wharf or Premises apart from the areas designated by the Company.
18. No permanent structures shall be erected and any installations must have the Company's prior written consent.
